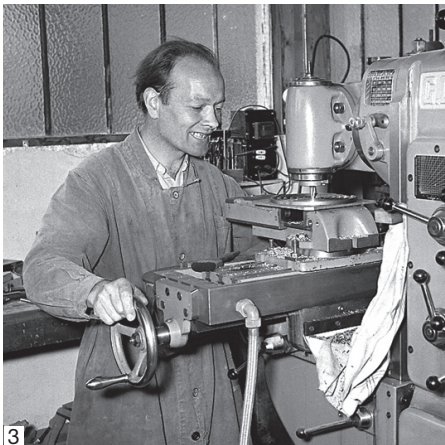
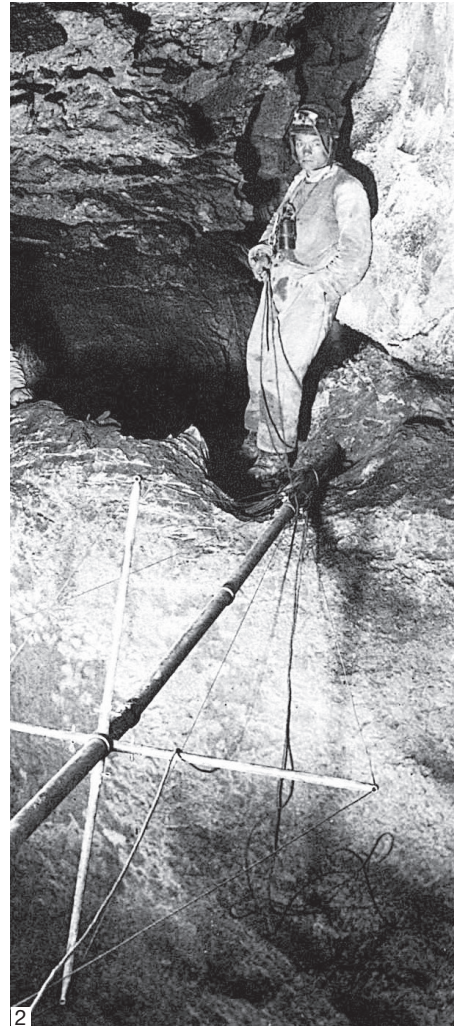

The Petzl brand on a product has always represented the commitment of the Petzl family to produce the best tools for its users.

The adventure began with Fernand Petzl's passion for caving, a passion to which he dedicated his talents as a craftsman. Petzl expertise began to grow with the design and crafting of solutions for ascending, descending, belaying and moving about in the dark. In 1970, the first "Fernand Petzl" brand products were produced in a workshop in Saint-Nazaire-Les Eymes, Isère, France. The Petzl company was created in 1975 and has grown into an international company that now employs over 800 people. Since its beginnings, it has preserved its family legacy and values: remaining independent and in control of its own decisions, developing a long-term vision, prioritizing people above all, and embracing its commitment to quality. Today, a family council, with Paul Petzl as president, ensures the continuity of the company.

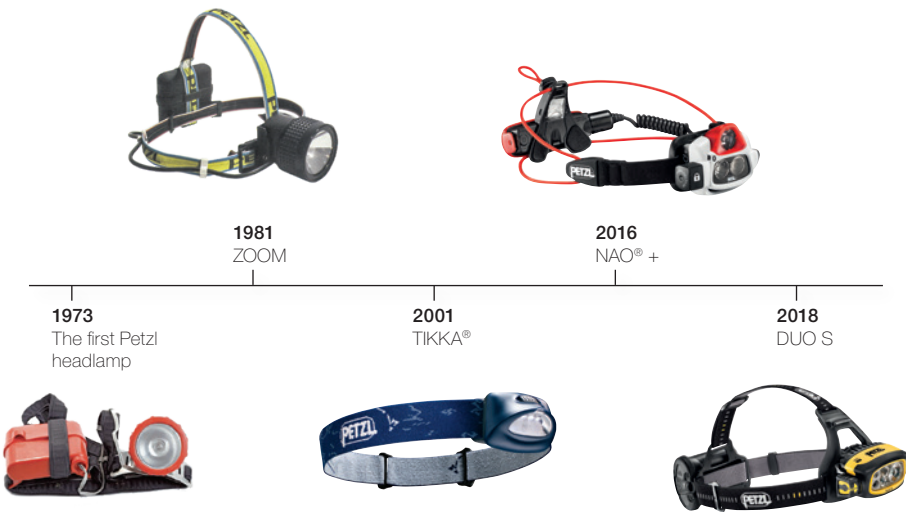

A pioneering business

To attain the inaccessible, you need to know how to reinvent yourself. Since the development of the first rope ascenders and descenders, which laid the foundation for rope progression, Petzl has been at the forefront of change and the emergence of new techniques. Headlamp lighting, belaying, rescue, ice climbing, glacier travel... In these and other fields, Petzl's innovations have allowed gear to evolve and practices to be reinvented. As proof of this dynamic activity, over 700 patents have been registered since 1970. These advances always result from a dialogue with the user, in order to understand his/her expectations and to provide the elements s/he needs. Petzl has always remained true to this method.

Petzl's philosophy for design and production is also based on accelerating change, transforming, and innovating in order to provide sports enthusiasts and professionals with the quality products they demand. Testing tower, experimentation center, individual inspections, LEAN manufacturing process - Petzl was a pioneer in all of these innovations.

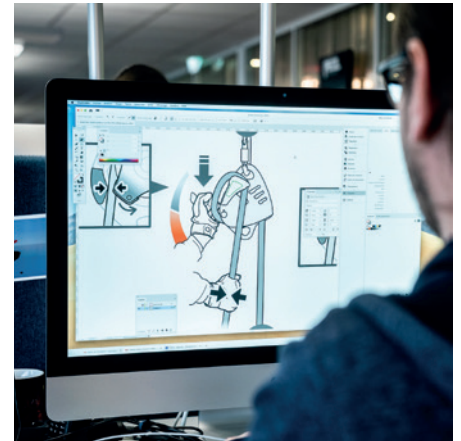
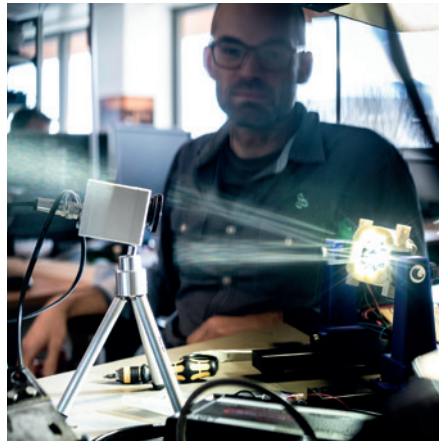


Expertise and dedication to quality

Design

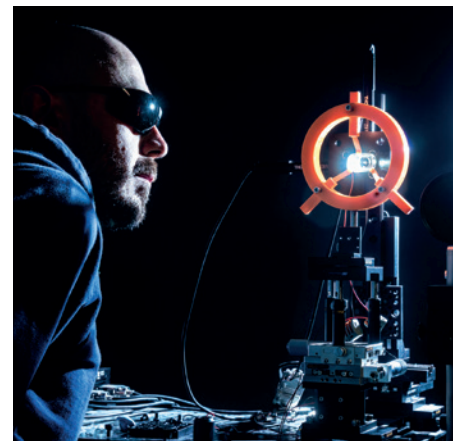

Testing

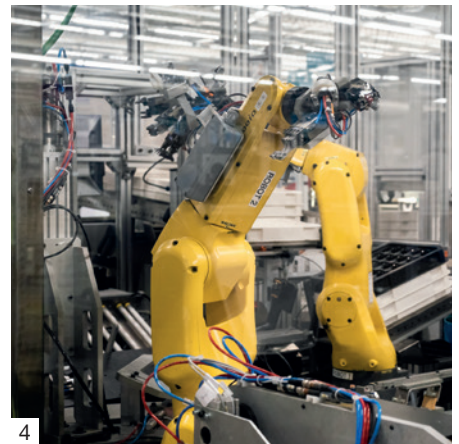

Examples of tests: dynamic fall tests, impact resistance, cyclic testing, performance, headlamp beam quality and burn times. They are complemented by testing in the field for ergonomics and reliability.

Production and inspection

Petzl's production sites are based in Crolles, Eybens, and Rotherens, France, and in Rawang, Malaysia. This production infrastructure is complemented by long-term partnerships with key suppliers in Europe and Asia. Our purchasing and quality control teams work closely with suppliers to guarantee a standard of product reliability and quality that meets our strict requirements. During the manufacturing phase, quality control is present at every step of the production chain. It combines automated and human inspections.

With protection against falling objects (EN 12492) and enhanced protection against lateral, front or rear impact (Petzl's TOP AND SIDE PROTECTION label), Petzl helmets efficiently protect the head during numerous activities: climbing, mountaineering, and now ski touring, where wearing a helmet is not yet the norm.

What are the different requirements for a ski touring helmet?

Ventilation:

In ski touring, the physical effort generated on the climb is considerable and requires appropriate gear. Only a lightweight, and most importantly, ventilated helmet can be comfortably worn from beginning to end of an outing.

Head protection:

Throughout a ski touring day, climbing or descending, the skier may face any of the following risks:

- rockfall:

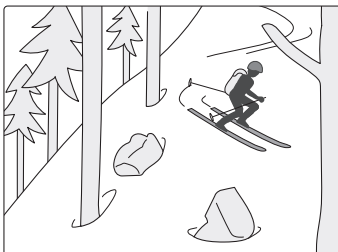


As in mountaineering, the skier may be exposed to rock or icefall, for example when climbing a couloir.

- side, front, and rear impacts:



A fall while climbing, on a steep or frozen slope, above a rocky outcrop.



A fall while descending, caused by hazards on the terrain: rocks, trees, ice blocks, crevasses, avalanches...

The best balance of ventilation and protection for the head will encourage participants to wear a helmet from beginning to end of an outing.

Why has Petzl pursued the creation of a new CE certification for ski touring helmets?

Currently there is no reference standard outlining the health and safety requirements for a ski touring helmet, unlike downhill skiing, which follows the guidelines of the EN 1077 class B standard.

Therefore, in order to obtain CE certification for a helmet used for ski touring, Petzl approached a certified body to create a standard that takes into consideration the practice, the environment and the dangers of ski touring. This reference standard is based primarily on:

- The requirements of the mountaineering helmet standard (EN 12492), to provide rockfall protection while ensuring maximum ventilation for comfortable wear during ascents
- Requirements for enhanced protection against lateral, front and rear impacts (as described in Petzl's test protocol for the TOP AND SIDE PROTECTION label).

This new reference standard is the PCSR-001 (Protocol for ski touring helmets). It is public, and available to other manufacturers for certification of their helmets.

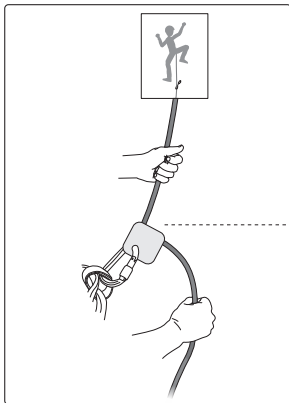

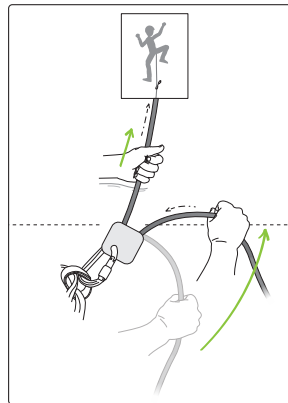
Petzl belay/rappel devices: standard usage techniques



Hand positioning

This hand position is valid regardless of the device used.

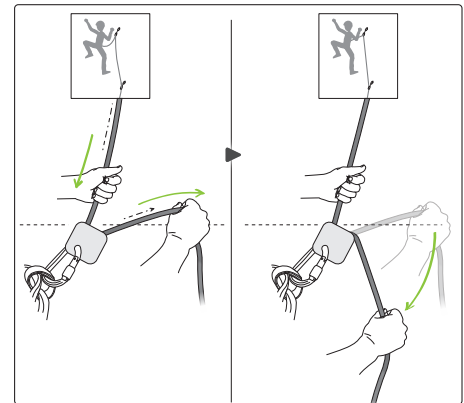
Your hand must never let go of the brake side of the rope.



Giving slack

To give slack, your brake-side hand pushes the rope towards the device, creating slack; your other hand pulls the rope through the device.

To repeat this movement, slide your brake-side hand along the rope, without ever letting it go.



Taking up slack

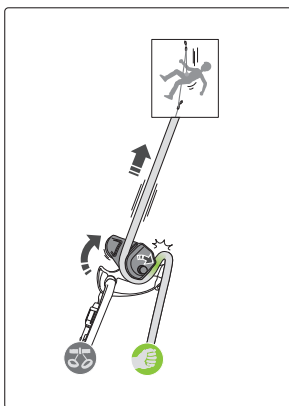
To take up slack, pull in the climber-side rope and pull the brake-side rope through the device. Never let go of the brake side of the rope.

Even though this hand sequence is common to all belay systems, **the position and the tightness of the grip of the brake-side hand are determined by the function and performance of the belay device.** These two features also affect the comfort of the belay.

Petzl belay systems: three types of devices

Belay devices with cam-assisted blocking

• Working principle



When a climber falls or rests, the rope tightens, and the cam pivots to pinch the rope and block it.

• Benefits:

- **comfortable belay, thanks to cam-assisted blocking**, which minimizes the strength required of the brake-side hand. This system is especially useful for working a route: trying a move over and over, holding the climber...
- **considerable leeway for brake-side hand position**, regardless of the angle between the climber-side and brake-side ropes
- **exceptionally comfortable descent**, thanks to the ergonomic handle that controls the progressive rope feed

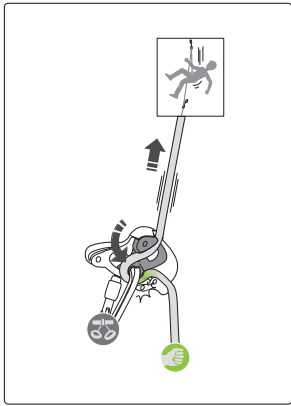

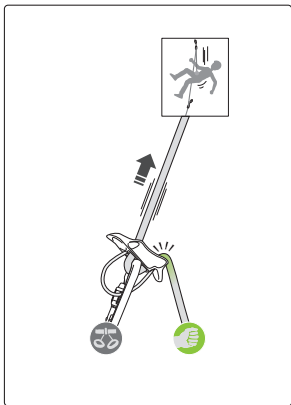

Types of ropes

Dynamic ropes

Single ropes ①

Ropes used as a single strand. These are mainly used for single-pitch climbing. Some climbers also use them for multi-pitch climbing or mountaineering.

Half ⑫ and twin ⑩ ropes

These are certified to two types of the CE EN 892 standard.

- Half ropes: ropes used in pairs that may be clipped separately or together during progression. They are recommended for rappels and to facilitate rope drag management. They provide extra safety in case one of the strands is cut by a falling rock or a sharp edge
- Twin ropes: ropes used in pairs that, unlike half ropes, must always be clipped together during progression. They are recommended for rappels

Multi-type ropes

Multi-type ropes are certified to three types of the CE EN 892 standard. They may be used as a single, half or twin rope.

Low stretch kernmantel ropes

Low stretch kernmantel ropes have low elongation and are very resistant to abrasion. They are designed for caving, canyoning, rope ascent or hauling, as well as for bolting a route.

Manufacture, finish and treatment: Petzl's choices



UIAA Guide Dry Treatment

The UIAA Guide Dry treatment is our most complete water repellent treatment for frequent use in wet environments. It makes a difference especially for regular use in extreme environments: ice climbing, mountaineering. This treatment also improves the rope's resistance to dirt and abrasion.

The UIAA Guide Dry treatment meets the requirements of the UIAA Water Repellent test. The results of this test indicate water absorption of less than 2 %.

The manufacturing process for UIAA Guide Dry treatment has two stages: the core is treated before the rope is braided, and then the entire rope is treated in order to minimize water absorption and penetration of fine particles into the rope.



Duratec Dry Treatment

Dry treatment, making the rope more resistant to water, dirt and abrasion. Handling, grip and other characteristics are retained longer in cold, wet conditions.



EverFlex Treatment

Special treatment stabilizes the core strands and improves consistency. Provides excellent grip and handling over time.



UltraSonic Finish

Ultrasonic welding bonds the core and sheath together at the rope ends. Gives greater durability and avoids frayed ends.



ClimbReady Coil

Specific coil makes the rope ready to use. Helps the user avoid initial uncoiling mistakes, and increases longevity.

Ice axe use and standards

The line of Petzl ice axes is composed of different families:

- ice axes for glacier travel and ski mountaineering
- classic mountaineering ice axes
- technical mountaineering ice axes
- ice axes for ice climbing and dry tooling

Each one of these ice axes has characteristics specific to its use on the terrain: length, shape of the shaft, of the pick...

The standards approach

In terms of standards, ice axes are divided into two types: type 1 and type 2. These types make a distinction between basic and technical ice axes.

This distinction is made using different tests:

- shaft center-load pull test
- shaft insertion strength test
- pick levering test

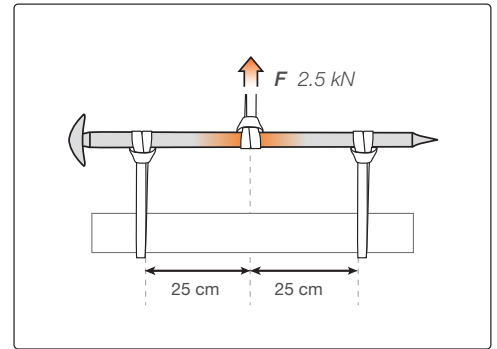

Type 1 ice axes

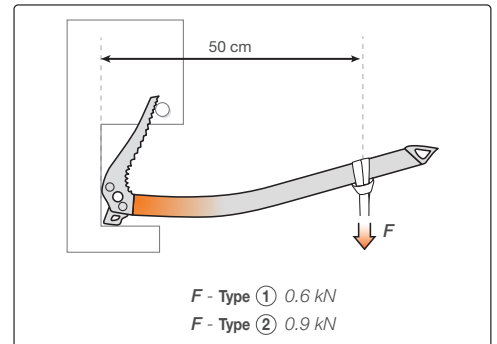
These ice axes have a lower strength requirement than Type 2 ice axes. They are generally used for skiing, glacier travel and classic mountaineering. For Type 1 ice axes, no marking is required, but if there is any, the marking is: B.

Type 2 ice axes

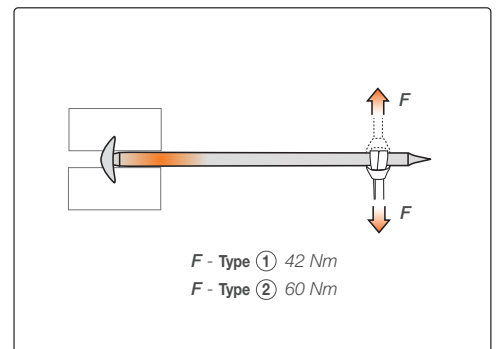
These ice axes have the highest strength required by the standard. They are primarily used for technical mountaineering, ice climbing and dry tooling. For Type 2 ice axes, marking is required. The marking is: T.

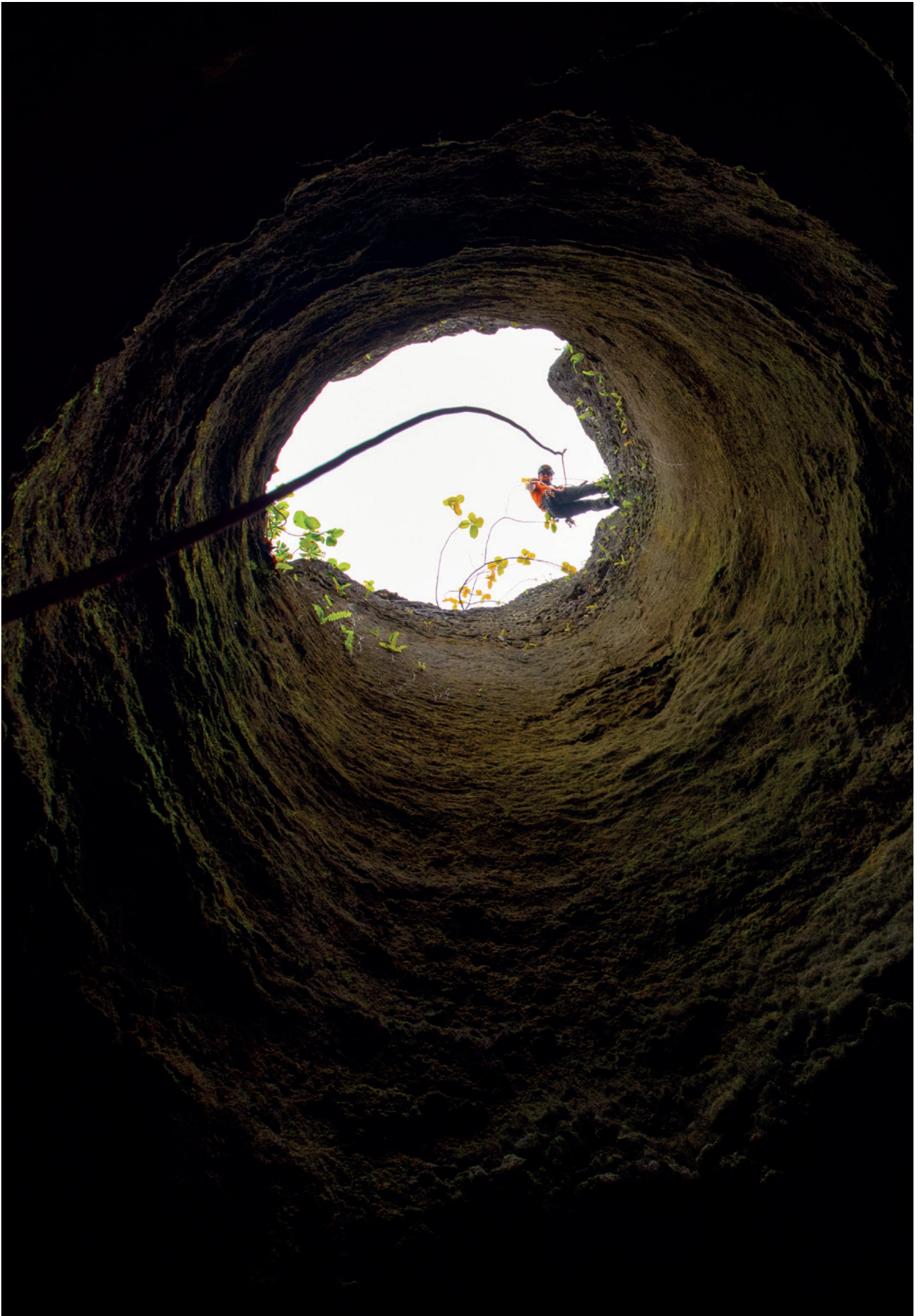

Because of their excellent handling, these ascenders are mainly used for ascending ropes. Their design also provides various ways to install the device on a rope to make a pulley system or haul a pack.



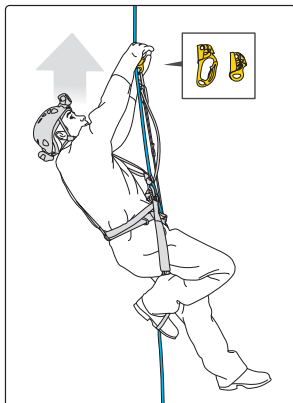

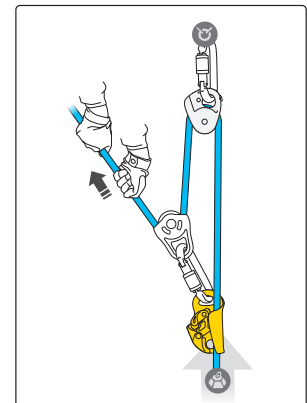

Lanyards

Lanyards are essential in many activities: via ferrata, caving, canyoning... Therefore, Petzl proposes lanyards, with or without energy absorbers, that respond to the specific needs of these activities.

Lighting performance as defined by the ANSI/PLATO FL 1 protocol

Petzl has chosen to follow the ANSI (American National Standards Institute) FL 1 protocol for measuring and communicating the lighting performance and burn times of our headlamps. This voluntary move allows the user to easily compare the lighting performance and burn times of different models of headlamps using standardized criteria.

Lighting performance: How is it measured?



- **Brightness (lumens)**

This measurement is taken between 30 and 120 seconds after the headlamp is turned on. It indicates the maximum light output, when the lamp is first turned on, using new batteries (included).



- **Lighting distance (meters)**

This is the maximum distance between the lamp and the location where only 0.25 lux of illumination remains. The measurement is taken when the lamp is turned on, using new batteries. Lighting distance depends directly on brightness, but mainly on the shape of the beam.



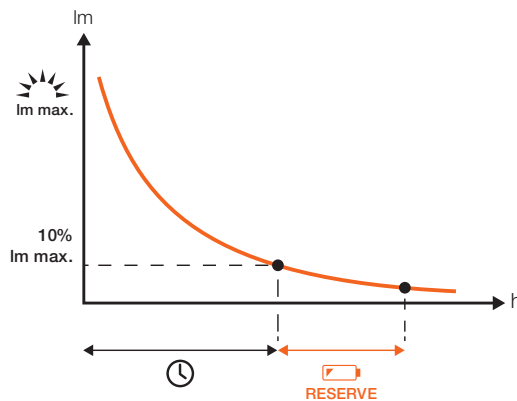
- **Burn time (hours)**

This corresponds to the length of time during which lighting is optimal. It is measured 30 seconds after the lamp is turned on and for as long as the lamp takes to drop to 10% of maximum light output.



- **Reserve lighting (outside scope of ANSI/PLATO FL 1 protocol)**

In addition to these measures, Petzl guarantees reserve lighting. Reserve lighting ensures a minimum light level for walking. However, the light may not be sufficient for fast-paced activities (such as running, mountain biking, skiing...).

Watertightness in conformity with IECX protocol: What do the IP ratings on Petzl headlamps mean?

A headlamp's watertightness is indicated by its IP rating. This index classifies the level of protection offered by equipment against intrusions by solids (e.g. dust) and liquids (e.g. water, oil).



Rating complies with the majority of headlamp uses, in rain, snow, or humidity. All Petzl headlamps are at least IPX4 rated (weather resistant).



Rating guarantees the headlamp is waterproof to -1 meter for 30 minutes in fresh water. The e+LITE headlamp is IPX7 rated.

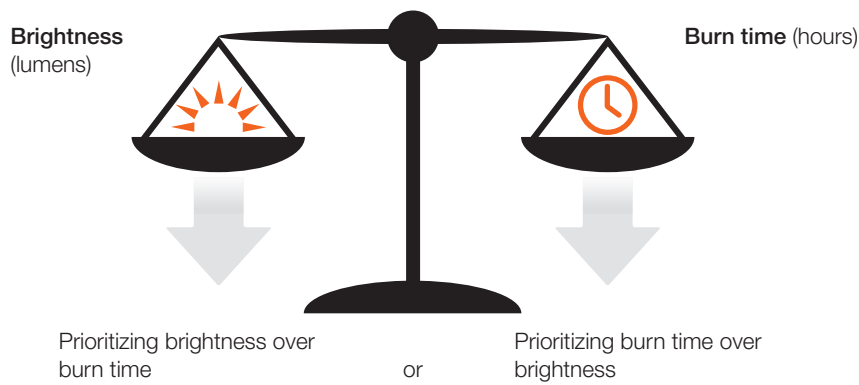


Rating guarantees the headlamp is dustproof, and waterproof to -1 meter for 30 minutes in fresh water. DUO headlamps are IP67 rated.

Optimizing headlamp performance with different lighting levels

Petzl headlamps are designed to satisfy the user's need for burn time and/or brightness. The choice is easy, with three brightness levels, depending on the activity (except DUO headlamps).

- for a shorter activity, requiring brightness: choose the MAX POWER level, which maximizes lumens over the first few hours
- for a longer activity, requiring good burn time management: choose the STANDARD level, which offers a lumen/time balance
- for an activity requiring little movement (reading, camping): choose MAX BURN TIME, which optimizes battery life and guarantees moderate lighting for a longer time

Rope access and confined space

Rope access work often involves environments at significant height. Work done in confined spaces entails challenges related to the lack of space and lack of means of autonomous progression.



Tree care

Not all tree work can be done using exterior means such as elevated platforms or ladders. In this case, to move and work, the arborist uses rope progression techniques.



Framing and roofing

In this type of work situation, the risk of slipping and falling is higher. A fall arrest system must therefore be installed to guard against these hazards.



Energy and networks

These environments are characterized by structures such as towers, antennas and wind turbines. The means of progression are varied and dependent directly on the structure, which does not always have a fall-arrest system in place.



Self-rescue

A firefighter who finds himself or herself trapped inside a burning structure must be prepared for self-evacuation and have the appropriate equipment on hand.



Hazardous areas

Where there is risk of explosion, the hazardous locations are classified by zone (ATEX and/or HAZLOC). All of the materials used must therefore conform with current regulations for this type of zone.



Technical rescue

Every day, rescue workers must adapt to new and dangerous situations, and require significant material support. Petzl proposes innovative, versatile and high-performance solutions to facilitate these missions.



Maintenance and workshops

Professionals working at concerts and shows, in workshops, in maintenance, in the energy and networks sector... all require practical and lightweight headlamps on a daily basis.



Tactical special forces

Tactical operations in a hostile environment require maximum safety in every situation, so being able to count on the quality and performance of the equipment is essential.

Avalanche risk: preparing for an excursion with the Yéti and Skitourenguru applications

Choosing a route suited to the most current snow conditions is key to reducing the risk of being caught in an avalanche. During this preparation phase, the role of digital tools is growing, thanks to community websites and to the availability of online geographical data. Since December 2019, snow sport enthusiasts have had access to Yéti and Skitourenguru, two free web applications that help them make good early planning decisions.

In the last four decades, avalanches have killed an average of 31 people every year in the mountains of France. In almost every case, this involved snow sports: ski touring, back-country skiing or snowshoeing.

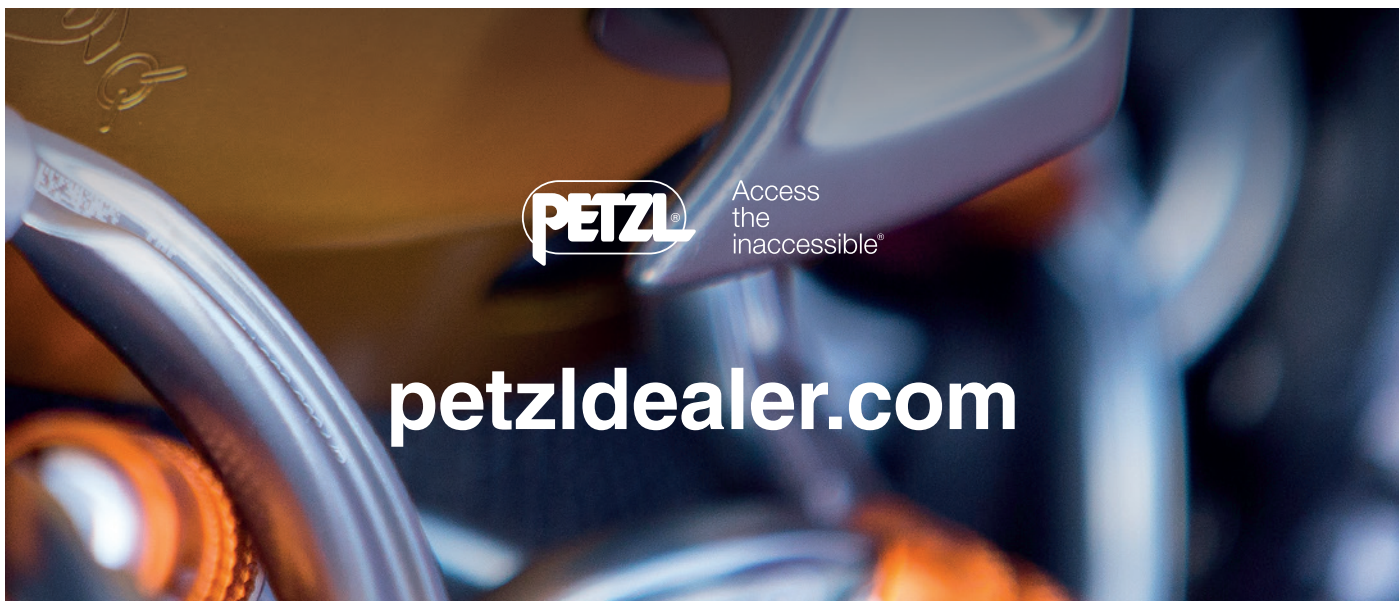
Too often overlooked, advance route-planning appears to be the key to limiting accidents. During this planning phase, Yéti and Skitourenguru help snow sport enthusiasts choose a suitable and safe route by identifying key passages, factors for consideration and options for retreat. Yéti and Skitourenguru allow users to make more informed decisions, providing all the information available the day prior to departure, in order for them to anticipate and better manage the risk before heading out.

Yéti is available to the general public on the Camptocamp community site: www.camptocamp.org/yeti.

Skitourenguru.ch has been available in Switzerland since 2014. Available to French users in the Belledonne, Lauzière and Beaufortin massifs as of December 2019, it is being gradually rolled out across France's mountain ranges: www.skitourenguru.ch.

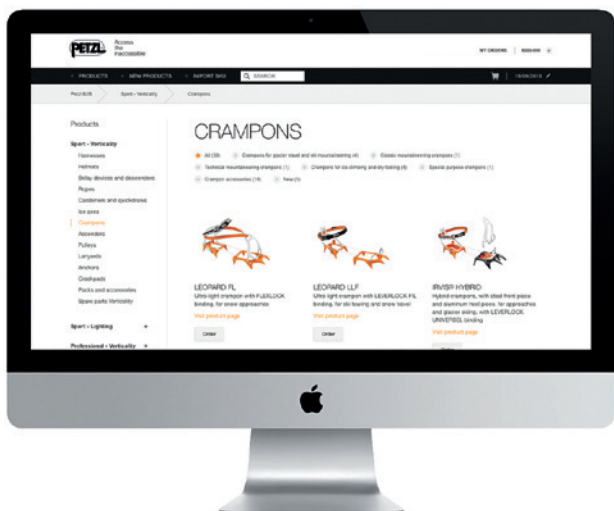
